

College of Engineering Undergraduate Scholarships

The College of Engineering (COE) has various scholarship funds which are available to qualified current undergraduate students. The funds available varies each year, individual awards range from \$350–\$2,000. Current scholarships available are listed below.

Eligibility: Applicants must be undergraduate students enrolled in the College of Engineering at UCSB and in good academic standing. Computer Science majors in the Colleges of Letters & Science or Creative Studies who are in good academic standing ARE eligible for scholarships designated for Computer Science majors.

Scholarships: Each scholarship has specific requirements, and applicants will be considered for all scholarships for which they are eligible.
