The spring 2021 grading option change deadline is **Friday, June 4 at 11:45 pm** in GOLD. Use the "modify" button to start the process from your schedule screen in GOLD.

REMINDER

- S21 All COE major courses **MAY** be taken for P/NP grading.
 - COE depts are: ChE, ECE, CMPSC, ME, MATRL, TMP*
*TMP 120 is letter-graded only.
- S21 Grading Option Change deadline is **Friday, June 4th** at 11:45 pm in GOLD.
- In the P/NP grading system:
 - C or higher = Pass
 - C- or lower = Not Passed (no units awarded)
- Not all L&S courses will be offered for P/NP grading. Check GOLD.
- Minimum 12 letter-graded units and no grades of NP required for Dean's Honors for the spring.

A few policy notes to consider:

- COE departments **have** opted in to offer their courses for P/NP grading, with the exception of TMP 120. COE undergraduate majors **have** opted in to allowing Pass grades to fulfill major requirements.

- The vast majority of courses in major-related departments (e.g., Math, Statistics, Physics, Chemistry) are offered for optional grading. You may select P/NP grading in these optional grading courses and apply a Pass grade to your COE major requirements. If a course is offered Letter Grade Only, you may not choose P/NP.

- If you are pursuing another major or minor in the Colleges of Letters & Science or Creative Studies and wondering about taking major/minor courses for P/NP grading, please discuss with your L&S/CCS major/minor department or check their website.

- To be eligible for the winter quarter Dean's Honors List you must complete at least 12 letter-graded units in winter quarter, with no grades of Not Passed. For more information about Dean's Honors click [here](#).
